Most Recent Interior Build-Outs

The largest traveler's assistance network company in the world with over 800 offices in 80 countries required a build-out of 5,000 SF of new construction in raw space. Special requirements of the build-out were Call Center that needs to operate 24/7 and numerous particular space requirements for operational efficiency purposes. The program included an inviting entrance, a Call Center that effectively fields calls from all over the world 24/7, a Medical Exam room, an employee lounge, a locker room and general offices and facilities that allow spontaneous communication amongst employees.

Lyons & Lurvey, PA Miami, FL

One of the most prominent criminal defense and civil litigation law firms in South Florida requested a build-out of 4,000 SF of new construction of raw space. The program required the maximization of the utilization of the space for 8 attorneys with a large conference room, lounge and server room all while ensuring the space was esthetically pleasing and efficient.

Inmarsat Inc Miami, FL

Publicly traded on the European Exchange, Inmarsat is the largest and most comprehensive global mobile satellite provider in the world. Inmarsat required a remodeling of 2,000 SF of existing space with a large conference room equipped with state of the art video conferencing equipment which could also be transformed into a training room, a lab to demonstrate and test equipment, employee lounge, a smaller conference room, numerous work stations in the core of the space, and a large server room which provisions had to be made to allow 6 satellites that were located on the roof of the building to connect to the office.
